Bobby McCurley, beloved husband of Cherie Diane (Knight) McCurley, passed from this life on Wednesday, October 21 after a lengthy battle with Multiple System Atrophy (MSA) at his home in Laurel MS. He is remembered locally as a Corvette and racing enthusiast as well as a gun collector and marksman. His life of public service included police officer in both Soso and Laurel Police Departments, Police Chief in Madison, AL and most recently Chief of Security and Surveillance at Bok Homa Casino.
