Anna O. Davis, 82, of Heidelberg passed away May 24, 2016, at Provision Living of Hattiesburg, MS.

Graveside services will be held at Shady Grove First Baptist Church Cemetery in Heidelberg, MS, on Saturday, May 28, 2016 at 11:30 a.m. The Rev. Bill Bolton will officiate.

Mrs. Davis lived most of her life in Heidelberg since moving from Smackover, Arkansas in 1944. Mrs. Davis graduated from Heidelberg High School in 1951. She was a homemaker until she returned to college to become a Registered Nurse, graduating in 1972. She worked most of her career at Watkins Hospital in Quitman, MS.
