Mrs. Anne Winton Scott, formerly Anne Bernice Bush of Laurel, MS, died January 25, 2016 at her home in Poway, CA.

Funeral services will be at Memory Chapel in Laurel at 1:00 pm on Saturday, January 30, 2016, the Rev. Randy Turner officiating, with graveside services to follow at Lake Park Cemetery. Visitation will be prior to the service from noon to 1:00 pm at Memory Chapel.

Born in Oxford, MS, Mrs. Scott moved to Laurel as a child, was Mississippi's Miss Hospitality in 1954, a cheerleader at Ole Miss, a speech therapist and teacher of developmentally disabled children, the wife of a career Navy fighter pilot who raised three boys while moving frequently, and then a successful real estate business owner and community leader in San Diego, CA. She was the consummate southern hostess, and could light up a room with the infectious smile and relentless energy of a woman who focused solely on the positive.

Survivors include her three sons – Steven and his wife Rita, Mark and Tammy, and Fred and Kristin Winton all of San Diego, CA, plus three grandchildren – Steven, Caitlin and Helena Winton; and her brother William W. Bush of Oxford, MS. She was preceded in death by her two husbands, Capt. Fred B. Winton, Jr., USN and Charles Carroll Scott, both of Laurel.
