



## Aubin Wells Clements

Aubin Wells Clements, 102, passed away at her home in Vancleave, MS on Thursday, November 14, 2013. She was born in Hattiesburg, MS to McKim Holiday Wells and Sarah Lemon Wells. She attended Belhaven College in Jackson, and married Howard Clayton Clements in 1936. She and Clayton moved from Laurel to Vancleave in 1969. Aubin retired from MS State Employment services in Pascagoula. After Clayton, Sr. passed away in 1998, Aubin lived at Villa Maria in Ocean Springs until two years ago when she moved in with Clayton, Jr. and his wife, Kathy. She passed away peacefully at the fish camp she loved so dearly.

She was an avid bridge player, loved fishing, playing cards with her family, cherished evening coffee time with close friends, and was loved by many. She was very active in church activities at Gautier Presbyterian Church, where she was a charter member. The congregation designated Clayton and Aubin as Elders Emeriti of the church in 1983 because of the extraordinary way they embodied their faith.

Survivors include one son, Clayton Clements, Jr. and his wife Kathy of Vancleave, MS; four grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
