Audree Sanderson Moffett, 91, died on June 10, 2016. Funeral Services will be held at Highland Baptist Church on Monday, June 13, 2016 at 3:00 p.m. with visitation beginning at 1:00 p.m. Burial will be at Hickory Grove Cemetery. Reverends Gene Douglas and Rusty Morecraft will officiate.

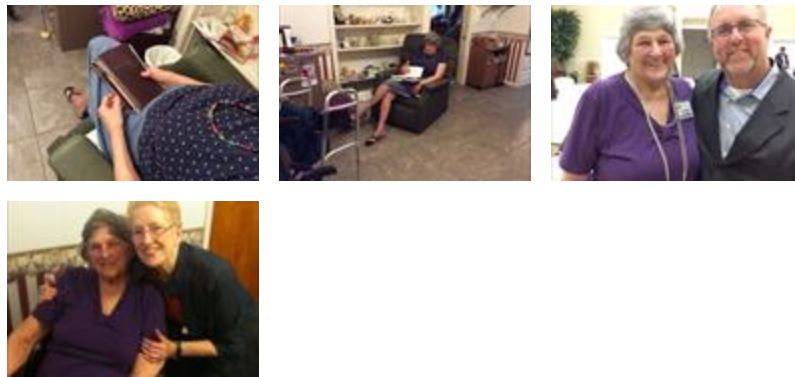

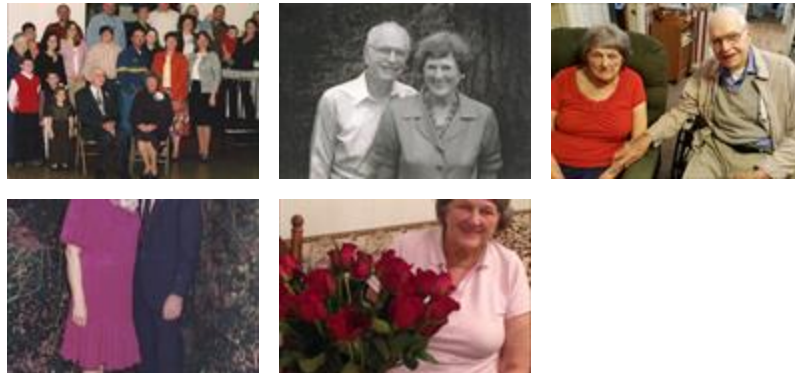
