Longtime resident of Montgomery, Barbara died Wednesday, September 6, 2017, at age 79, born September 27, 1937 in Mississippi & raised in the Jones County Laurel-Sandersville area. 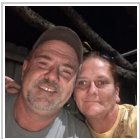

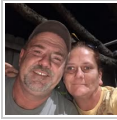
