Bettie, known as "MiMi" to her grandchildren and great grandchildren, celebrated her 85th birthday on October 7, 2017. She fought battles with health issues, including an open heart surgery, multiple strokes, kidney problems and infection, ending in her recent visit to the hospital. Her life was one of living as a person who cared greatly for her friends and family. She was loved and admired by everyone who ever ate a meal at her house, and was known by them for "cooking enough for an army" on holiday visits. She was a member of the Pachuta United Methodist Church and also attended services at the Lake Eddins Church. She loved the folks at Lake Eddins, especially her walking buddies and Church folks. Bettie retired from Sears as supervisor of the service group in Laurel. She also worked at J. C. After 20 years at the lake, she moved into the LynnWood Senior Care home in Laurel, MS and has been there for over a year.
