Carl Dexter Ford, age 84, passed away on Tuesday, August 3, 2021.

Mr. Ford was born March 6, 1937 in Taylorsville, MS, the son of Dexter D. and Alene Robinson Ford. He married Nancy Parker on June 6, 1965. She preceded him in death on February 21, 2019.

He earned his Juris Doctor degree from Ole Miss in 1965 and practiced law in Laurel all of his career.

He was a life member of the Sons of Confederate Veterans and served as Commander Mississippi Division SCV, 2nd Lt Commander Mississippi Division SCV, Judge Advocate Mississippi Division SCV, and Inspector General Mississippi Division SCV. He was a Charter Member of Camp #227 SCV Jones County Rosin Heels, Camp Commander Jones County Rosin Heels Camp #227 SCV, and Judge Advocate Jones County Rosin Heels Camp #227 SCV. He was also a member of the Jones County Republican Party and the Jones County Bar Associate, a Life Member of the University of Mississippi Alumni Association, and a Veteran of the United States Naval Reserve. He was of the Southern Baptist Faith and was a member of Bethlehem Baptist Church.

For the last year of Carl's life, he was cared for by Guardian Angels Assisted

Living and Southern Care Hospice. They provided comfort and friendship.

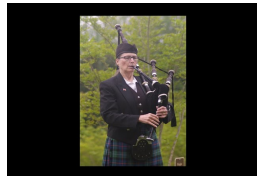
