Carol Harry, 70, of Seagrove Beach, Florida, born October 3, 1947, passed away at her mother's residence in Laurel, Mississippi, on Thursday, December 7, 2017.

Graveside services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday, December 9, 2017, at Lake Park Cemetery, 1220 Old Bay Springs Road, in Laurel, with Rev. Mark Anderson officiating.

Ms. Harry was born in Columbia and graduated from Laurel High School and Mississippi University for Women and received her master's degree in political science from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. She worked in banking in Houston, Texas, before beginning a long career as a flight attendant for Delta Airlines, living in New Orleans, Louisiana, Tiburon, California, and Dallas, Texas, followed by retirement to Seagrove Beach, Florida. Ms. Harry was raised going to the First United Methodist Church in Laurel, and was a long-time member of Point Washington United Methodist Church in Santa Rosa Beach, Florida.

She is preceded in death by her father, John Jason Harry, III, and brother, John Jason Harry, IV.
