



Charles Allen Stewart

June 10, 1947 - January 17, 2013

Dr. Charles Allen “Chuck” Stewart, 65, passed away at his residence in Palm Springs, CA, on January 17, 2013. He was preceded in death by his parents, C. T. “Red” Stewart and Mae Valentine Stewart of Laurel.

Dr. Stewart was a graduate of R. H. Watkins High School. He attended Tulane University where he earned his bachelor’s degree in French Literature and his doctoral degree from Tulane University School of Medicine.

He began his career as an intern at Los Angeles County-USC Medical Center where he was a recipient of a Fellowship in Nuclear Medicine. He completed his residency at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center in Diagnostic Radiology and also served as an Assistant Professor of Radiology at USC School of Medicine. He began work at Rancho Los Amigos Rehabilitation Center in 1979 as a Nuclear Medicine Physician and became Chief of Nuclear Medicine in 1987. He became Acting Chief Medical Director in 2004. Dr. Stewart retired from Rancho Los Amigos Rehabilitation Center in June of 2012 and had recently moved to Palm Springs, CA.

Dr. Stewart is survived by many family members and friends including Matthew Bartholomew of Palm Springs, CA; Judy Valentine of Laurel, Neil (Donna) Valentine of Brandon; Charla (Carl) Willis of Austin, TX; Candy Morison (Phillip) of Mandeville, LA; Donna (Wayne) Black, Peggy Robinson, Charles (Mary) Watson of Laurel; and Larry (Katie) Robinson of Madison.

A celebration of life memorial service will be held at the Rogers-Green House in Laurel on Saturday, February 23, 2013 from 1:00 p.m. till 3:00 p.m. with
