Cooper David Pope, 60, was born June 4, 1964, in Hammond, Louisiana. He passed away on September 12, 2024, at his residence in Laurel, Mississippi.

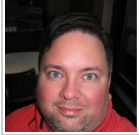

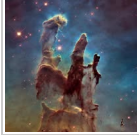
