Currie Haig McArthur, of Laurel, MS, a long time resident of Mobile, AL departed this life peacefully to be with his Lord and Savior on December 27, 2010, at home with his loving family by his side and supported by his devoted caregivers, Julia, Patricia, Valerie and Erma.

He was a member of Salem Heights Baptist Church in Laurel, MS and formerly of Pleasant Valley United Methodist Church of Mobile, AL.

He was born in Pugwash, Nova Scotia on Christmas Day, 1918, the sixth of eight children. He served his country during World War II in the U. S. Air Force and flew 60 combat missions. He retired in 1964 and then worked for the U. S. Postal Service until retirement in 1980.
