



Donald "Glen" Pyeatt

March 25, 1940 - October 28, 2024

Donald "Glen" Pyeatt, 84, passed away Monday, October 28, 2024, at his home in Laurel, MS.

Glen was born on March 25, 1940 in Clyde, TX. He graduated from Abilene High School in 1958. Shortly after high school he moved his young family to Arizona where he first worked at a gas plant then eventually started his own business maintaining irrigation engines for farmers. He sold the business before moving back to Texas where he met Tammy. The two settled in Laurel, MS, in 1990, where he managed the natural gas plant for over 20 years before retiring.

Glen was a private and commercial pilot and owned several planes throughout his life. He loved to fly and talk about his experiences as a pilot, including his time spent as a crop duster and in the Civil Air Patrol in Arizona. He was a curious, self-taught, and intelligent man who knew how to fix anything. He was known for his creative inventions for solving issues. His favorite activity though was sitting on his porch, drinking coffee, and enjoying his view.

Glen was preceded in death by his mother, Juanita Pyeatt, his daughter, Kimber White, and his grandson, Landon Davidson.

Glen is survived by his wife of 38 years, Tammy Pyeatt of Laurel, MS; his daughter, Desi Cuddihy of Fall City, WA; his mother-in-law, Sheila Milliken of Laurel, MS; his grandchildren Erin Hart-Rodriguez (Javier), Stephanie Hart, Jacob Hart, Chelsea Pyeatt (Matt), Taylor Lawrence (Antwon), and Austin White; and his great-grandchildren Alina, Landon, Kyler, Alysa, and Kaden Lawrence, Apollo and Nico Rodriguez, and Kingston Pyeatt Fortier.

Glen is also survived by his brothers, Ray-Gene Pyeatt of Abilene, TX, and Tommy Pyeatt (Leann) of Fort Worth, TX; and his sister, Darlene Rousselot (Lee) of Midland, TX.
