Dorothy Windham Lindsay, born May 1, 1927, peacefully passed away Saturday, December 10, 2022, at the age of 95.

Dorothy, lovingly known as “DotDot”, was born in Sandersville, MS to John Walton and Maggie Lee Culpepper Windham. Dorothy was a retired federal employee who traveled the world during her career, living in Washington D.C., Europe, Australia, and Guam before retiring in 2007 to the island of Kauai, Hawaii and eventually returning to Mississippi in 2014. Born on May Day, Dot lived up to the theme of her birthday with her love of all things blooming. She arose early each day to work in her flower garden, weedeating and moving dirt until just a few months prior to her death. Dot lived an adventurous life, beginning with her first job in the summer of 1943, where, at the age of 16, she took a train from Laurel, MS to Washington, D.C. to work as a summer hire stenographer in the War Department. Dot graduated from Sandersville High School, Jones County Junior College, and the University of Southern Mississippi, earning bachelor’s and master’s degrees. Dot enjoyed studying the Bible, crocheting, watching Fox News, and was knowledgeable in all things golf and tennis.
