Edith Murphy Davis went to be with the Lord on December 11, 2010, in DeFuniak Springs, Florida, where she had lived with her son and his wife, Charles and Linda Davis for the past 16 years. A visitation will be held at Memory Chapel Funeral Home on Monday, December 13, 2010, from 5:00 to 7:00 PM with a memorial service at the chapel on Tuesday, December 14th at 10:00 AM with Rev. Willis Cochran officiating. Edith graduated from Jones County Agricultural High School in Ellisville and trained as a nurse at Mississippi State Hospital in Laurel. As a Registered Nurse she worked at Boone Ramsey Clinic with Dr. Tom Ramsey and Dr. H. L. Boone, then Boone Clinic added Dr. E. E. Ellis, Dr. George Bush and Dr. Ken Grafton. Later Boone Clinic became West Ridge Family Clinic and she was still working there when she retired at 78, having enjoyed being an R.N. for over 55 years. Edith was an active member of Kingston United Methodist Church (baptized at Evangel Temple), taught Sunday School class for many years, was a member of United Methodist Women and a member of Laurel Chapter #24 Order of the Eastern Star. She was a member of District 8 Nurses Association and the National Nurses Association. Edith was born September 21, 1918, to Evelyn "Evie" Shoemake Murphy and Archie Michael Murphy, the youngest of six children. Her parents and all of her siblings, Calvin, Clemon, Archie, Cleo and Juanita predeceased her, but left her with many nieces and nephews that she loved dearly. Her husband of over 50 years, Charles Cleveland "Spud" Davis preceded her in death. Edith is survived by one son, Charles J. Davis and his
