High School. While

attending Jones County Junior College, he played football and was on the
track and field team

for the Bobcats. He attended Delta State university and graduated from
William Carey College.

As a junior in high school, Latrelle accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and
shortly afterwards

dedicated his life to Christian ministry. He faithfully served as State Youth
Director for the

Baptist Missionary Association of Mississippi for twenty-five years. As State
Youth Director, he

organized events, camps, and conferences for young people from elementary
to college age

throughout Mississippi. He invested in the lives of young people through Christian education and discipling them in Christian service.

Latrell served on staff at Parkview Baptist Church, Lebanon Baptist Church and First Baptist

Church of Louin in education, youth and music minister capacities in his early years of ministry

and on the staff of Southeastern Baptist College. Following college, he was on the faculty of

Bay Springs High School as a classroom teacher and assistant coach.
