



## Elaine Ford Eaton

April 28, 1916 - December 4, 2011

Elaine Ford Eaton, of Taylorsville, died peacefully in her sleep at her home on Sunday evening, December 4, 2011. She was born on April 28, 1916 to Elvie Carr and Emmett Howard Ford.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 am Wednesday, December 7, 2011 at First Baptist Church of Taylorsville. Rev. Frankie Clark and Rev. Eric Estus will officiate.

Mrs. Eaton graduated from Taylorsville High School at fifteen and graduated from MSCW in 1936 with a double major in English and history. She taught at Taylorsville High School for many years.
