Eugenia McWilliams Bounds was born April 20, 1917, the fifth of eleven children of Emma Long and Walter Ross McWilliams in DeKalb, Mississippi. She passed away at her home as she had requested on Tuesday, June 12, 2018. She chose a life of simple quietude, grounded by her faith in God and guided by her commitment to follow the teachings and example of Jesus Christ.

She was a loving wife to her husband of fifty-two years, Waldo Bounds, prior to his passing in 1992; a devoted mother to her one daughter, Carol Bounds Tillery; a doting grandmother to her two granddaughters, Alicia Tillery (Mrs. Richard) Dunlap and Ellen Tillery (Mrs. Richard) Morrow; and a proud great grandmother to her two great grandsons, Martin and Douglas Dunlap and to her three great granddaughters, Elsie, Sophie, and Mary Morrow.
