Gladys Whiteside McCreight, 89, of Laurel, died Monday, November 22, 2010, at her home after an extended illness.

Mrs. McCreight was a registered nurse and was employed for 37 years at Jones County Community Hospital which is currently known as South Central Regional Medical Center.
