James V. Sanders Jr., known to friends and family as Jimmy, passed away on February 23rd, 2018 at 5:00am. He was 79 years old.

James was born in Greenville, Mississippi on August 21, 1938, to James V. Sanders Sr. and Myrtle C. (Trest) Sanders. He graduated from Sandersville High School in 1958. James also earned an Associate of Arts degree from Jones County Junior College in Ellisville, Mississippi.
