John Pat Myers, 92, of Laurel, died Tuesday, July 9, 2013 at his residence. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Monday, July 15, 2013 at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, with burial to follow at Lake Park Hills Cemetery. Father Mike Thornton and Father Ken R. Landry will officiate.
