Johnie D. Parker, 94, of Taylorsville died Monday, November 15, 2010, at South Central Regional Medical Center in Laurel.

Funeral services will be held at 10 am Thursday, November 18, 2010, at Memory Chapel with burial in Clear Creek Cemetery in Smith County. Rev. Ken Regan will officiate.

Mr. Parker was a farmer and of the Baptist faith. He served in the U. S. Army during World War II, where he fought in Algeria French Morocco, Tunisia, Sicily, Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland, Ardennes and Central Europe battles.
