Johnny Floyd McLeod, 68, died Tuesday, May 30, 2017 at the University of Mississippi Medical Center after a valiant battle with leukemia. He was surrounded by his loving wife and children. A service celebrating his life will be held Saturday, June 3, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. at First Baptist Church of Laurel with visitation beginning at 1:30 p.m. Dr. Randy Turner will officiate.

Johnny, a native of Leakesville, MS, was born May 14, 1949 to Floyd McLeod and Mae Dueitt McLeod. He graduated from the University of Southern Mississippi. After retiring from Masonite Corporation, Johnny founded Agri-Bynd, LLC. He was an active member of First Baptist Church of Laurel where he taught children's Sunday School for many years.
