Judith Young Holifield (Judi) passed away peacefully at home, surrounded by her family, on Saturday, December 13, 2025.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Louis Young and Ethel Jefcoat Young of Soso, MS; her siblings, Julane Young and Jeff Young; and her husband, Neal Holifield.

She is survived by her children, Carrie Parker Cullum (Brian) of Madison, MS, Jenny Parker Steelman (Houston) of Nashville, TN, and Allen Holifield (Skyla) of Laurel, MS; her grandchildren, Joseph Cullum and Katie Cullum of Madison, MS, Zach Maples of Laurel, MS; and her companion of many years, Lowery Hicks.

Born in Laurel, MS on January 11, 1954, Judi graduated from West Jones High School and completed her degree in Music Education at the University of Southern Mississippi. She began her career as a choral director at Northeast Jones High School and went on to serve many other schools and churches, touching countless lives as a music educator. After an extensive teaching career, she put her passion for the arts to work at the Mississippi Arts Commission, and ended her career as the Executive Director of Laurel Main Street.

Whether as a teacher or community leader, Judi's door was always open for advice, big ideas, and encouragement. This open-door policy shaped her retirement, as her front porch became her new office. She leaves behind a legacy of excellence ingrained in all who knew her well.
