L. B. Nichols, 92, of Laurel, MS, died Wednesday, February 8, 2012, at the Collins State Veterans Home.

Born in Taylorsville, MS, on October 21, 1919, as a young man, L. B. Proudly served in the U. S. Army during World War II.
