June 13, 1911 - July 7, 2011

L. E. Shepperd, 100, of Laurel, died Thursday, July 7, 2011 at Lynwood Senior Care in Laurel. Funeral services will be held at 2 pm Sunday, July 10, at Pleasant Ridge Baptist Church with burial to follow in the church cemetery. The body will be placed in the church at 1 pm. Rev.
