Margaret Marie Brumbeloe Hitt, 97, died January 26, 2022, in Collins, Mississippi. Born on December 7, 1924, to Julia Ann Josephine Dobbins Brumbeloe and Milford Lumpkin Brumbeloe, Margaret grew up in the Skirum community on Sand Mountain, Alabama, and later finished her education at Boligee, Alabama and Eutaw, Alabama.

On January 5, 1942, Margaret married Edwin Auston Hitt at Eutaw, Alabama. They lived in Boligee where they raised their three children Milford Irving, James Edwin, and Margaret Ann. In May of 1957, the family moved to Laurel, Mississippi, where Edwin and Margaret would live for the next 53 years.
