



## Margaret Ethel Wilby Borrell

April 14, 1941 - June 2, 2015

Margaret Ethel Wilby Borrell, 74, of Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, died on Tuesday, June 2, 2015 after a long illness. A graveside memorial service will be held in Laurel, Mississippi, where her ashes will be interred at the Hickory Grove Cemetery on October 10, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. An earlier memorial service was held in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania.

Margaret Ethel was born on April 14, 1941 in Laurel, Mississippi. Her parents were Margaret Gatlin and William A. Wilby; Her maternal grandparents were Stella Morris Gatlin and Dr. Joseph Savan Gatlin; Her paternal grandparents were Ethel Johnson and Alfred Wilby, of Laurel, all deceased. Margaret was a graduate of George S. Gardiner High School and the University of Southern Mississippi. She retired as a special education teacher from Jackson County, Mississippi and was honored as Teacher of the Year in both 2003 and 2004 from Jackson County Schools. She served on the Superintendent's Advisory Board. She also received the Community Action Disability Award for Service and Dedication from the Gulf Coast Head Start Program early in her educational career.

She is remembered for her enjoyment of gardening, reading and her sense of humor. She loved her children and granddaughters and was fortunate in moving to Chambersburg, Pennsylvania to be near her son, Dr. Joseph Borrell, of Shippensburg University after losing her home in Vancleave, Mississippi to Hurricane Katrina.

Survivors include her sons, Dr. A. Joseph Borrell, III, of Chambersburg,

Pennsylvania and William J. Borrell, of Tampa, Florida; granddaughters Elinor Jane Borrell and Alexis Joy Borrell. Her sisters, Betty Wilby Carroll of Decatur, Georgia and Savan Wilby Wilson of Fairhope, Alabama and Brother-in-Law, Lee Carroll also mourn her loss.
