Marvin Latrelle Bush, Jr. passed away October 24th in Laurel, MS. He was born on November 23rd, 1952 in Laurel, MS to Marvin Latrelle “M.L.” Sr. and Sarah Bush.

He is survived by Edward “Buddy” Broome; siblings Charley Bush and Rachel Bush-Howell (Tim); nieces Erin Howell, Christy Howell (John), Amanda Kennedy (Grant); and 7 great-nieces and nephews.

He attended West Jones High School and was an alumnus of Mississippi State University with a degree in Business Administration. A lifelong lover of the ocean, Marvin graduated from State in a non-traditional fashion, mailing in his last semester’s final papers from various ports after negotiating a deal with his professors upon receiving an offer to co-captain a boat around the Caribbean. Marvin was also a licensed tug boat captain, sailboat racer, diver, and even built his own sailboat.

Marvin grew up in the Bush Dairy family, and was an accomplished businessman himself, having previously owned Catron Oil, working as a wholesale jobber, and owning several Texaco Convenience Stations. His most recent venture was co-owning Right at Home of the Pine Belt with his sister, Rachel.
