



## Mitchell David "Mitch" Mauldin

November 26, 1952 - February 14, 2012

Mitchell David Mauldin, of Laurel, died peacefully at home on Tuesday, February 14, 2012, at the age of 59. He died as he lived, with complete faith and trust in his Lord.

Mitch was a member of First Baptist Church where he served as a deacon. He was co-owner of United Roofing and Construction Company for many years before retiring to develop Mauldin Properties.

Mitch was a long time member of the Rotary Club, the 100 Club, served on the board of directors for the National Roofing Contractors Association, and was an active fundraiser for the American Cancer Society and Hope Lodge. He was an avid hunter and fisherman who loved the outdoors. One of his favorite hobbies was firing up his smoker and cooking ribs for his friends.
