



Nancy "Nan" Elizabeth Hathorn

September 25, 1936 - October 31, 2023

Nancy Elizabeth Hathorn was born September 25th, 1936 and departed this life to be with the Jesus she had long loved and served on October 31, 2023, surrounded by her family members who sang her favorite hymn, "It Is Well with My Soul," at her bedside in South Central Regional Medical Center.

Nan was preceded in death by her parents, ML and Beatrice Graham; her son, Kenneth "Lee" Parker; her brother, Gerald "Jerry" Graham; her brothers-in-law, Aubrey Cooper and Robert Winpigler; and her sister-in-law, Ann Graham.

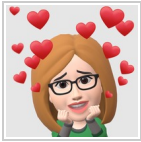
