June 9, 1919 - September 7, 2014

Nancy A. Sault, 95, passed away at home on Sunday, September 7, 2014, surrounded by her family. She was born in Gadsden, AL on June 9, 1919, to Hal Fort Atkinson and Nanita Atkinson, and grew up in Alabama and Laurel, MS. She met her husband, Bob, in Mobile, AL while he was in the US Navy. They married in November, 1944, at First Presbyterian Church in Laurel and spent their honeymoon in New York City before Bob shipped out during WWII. Their daughter, Becky, was born in Laurel.

Nancy and Bob lived in Visalia, CA from 1954 until 1980 when they retired to a tree farm here in Laurel that had been in her family since the early 1920s. She loved teaching children, especially in Sunday school. She spent most of her life making a home for her family. She and Bob loved camping and traveling and especially enjoyed building roads on the farm. She had a wide circle of neighbors and friends.

The Saults were charter members of Westminster Presbyterian Church in Laurel where they served for many years, singing in the choir, teaching Sunday school, working to build the church, and supporting many different ministries.

Visitation will take place at Memory Chapel 5-7 p. m. on Tuesday, September 9, 2014. Service will be held at Westminster Presbyterian Church at 10 a. m. Wednesday, September 10, 2014. The body will be placed in the church at 9 a. m. Wednesday. Elders of the church will serve as pallbearers.
