



## Nell Spence Damon

Nell Spence Damon, age 94, passed away on March 25, 2018 in Mobile, Alabama.

Miss Damon was born in Laurel, Mississippi, where she lived most of her life until moving to a retirement community in Mobile in 2011 to be closer to family.
