“ There was a time, years ago, when I saw Nicky everyday...even weekends at Bethlehem Nazarene Church and sometimes behind the preachers house in the pasture on Sunday afternoons playing baseball or in the pond at Uncle Shine's; more than one 4th of July celebration and in every Christmas “Program” at Bethlehem from the time we moved back to Mississippi in 1957 until I left home after graduation and Dad's death in August of 1967.
