Pamela Rae Darden-Bridges, age 60, of Laurel, MS, passed away unexpectedly on July 21, 2024 at St. Dominic Hospital in Jackson, MS.

Pamela was a graduate of Ventura High School (Class of '82) and later at IBC (International Bible College) in San Antonio, Texas with a Bachelors Degree in Music.
