Peggy "Patsy" Pauline Walters Davis, 86, of Ellisville, died Monday, October 30, 2023, at South Central Regional Medical Center in Laurel. Her unwavering faith and assurance of going to her "heavenly home" in her final hours was a testimony that will always be treasured.
