Ralph L. Campbell , 85 years of age, entered his Heavenly home surrounded by his loving family on February 24, 2024 after a lengthy illness following several difficult heart surgeries and weekly dialysis.

Ralph was owner of Memory Chapel Funeral Home since 1973. He was happiest when he was serving people in their time of need, and was never ready to “retire,” and has said many times the only pay check he ever earned was from a funeral home.

Ralph loved His Lord and was a member of First Baptist Church, Laurel. He served as deacon and on numerous committees. He also supported Laurel serving on many boards and participating in civic affairs. He was a member and served as president of Mississippi Funeral Directors.

Ralph Campbell was predeceased by his parents, Leslie (Bay) and Lulu Rayner Campbell of Louin, MS, his “other parents” Adrian and Evelyn Culpepper of Meridian, MS.

He is survived by his loving, supportive wife of 65 years, Fay Culpepper Campbell, daughter, Leslie; son, Richard Barry; daughter-in-law, Jennifer; and was “Poppy” to his beloved granddaughter, Jocelyn. He is also survived by his sister, Doris (James) Montgomery , sister -in -law, Kay (Glenn) Pugh,

nieces, nephews, other relatives, numerous friends and his faithful, devoted employees.

His health necessitated his spending his last days at Guardian Angels Assisted Living. The family want to say “thank you” to the nursing attendants who treated him as their own family. He was fond of each of you.
