



## Robert S. (Bob) Sault

July 30, 1919 - October 24, 2014

Robert S. (Bob) Sault, 95, died at home on Friday, October 24, 2014.

Funeral services will be at Westminster Presbyterian Church on Tuesday, October 28, 2014, at 10 a.m. with burial to follow at Lake Park Cemetery. The body will be placed in the church at 9 a.m. Tuesday. Rev. Mike Allen will officiate.

Mr. Sault was born in Wilmington, California on July 30, 1919. He graduated from Compton College in 1941 and served four years in the U. S. Navy during World War II. After the war, he attended the University of Alabama. He worked thirty years for the Southern California Edison Company. In 1990, he retired to become a tree farmer in Laurel.

He married Nancy Atkinson Sault of Laurel, MS on November 20, 1944. They spent their honeymoon in New York City at Christmastime. Their daughter, Becky, was born in 1947.

He enjoyed traveling, boating, and working in the woods. A life-long electrician, he used his creativity and ingenuity to make life better for those around him. After living in California for most of his life, he loved Mississippi and tried to make it a special place to live.

His beloved wife, Nancy, died six weeks ago. He is survived by his daughter, Becky Moore; son-in-law, Karl Moore; grandson, Bobby Nathe; brother, Jay Sault; and nieces and nephews.
