Robert Kittrell Lyle, born October 15, 1940, died Thursday, January 9, 2014. Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday, January 11, 2014, at Memory Chapel with burial to follow at Shady Grove Cemetery in Jones County. Rev. Randy Clark will officiate.

Mr. Lyle was born in Laurel to G. W. Lyle and Mamie Robertson Lyle. He graduated in 1958 from George S. Gardiner High School. He joined the Air Force, served four years, and was honorably discharged.
