March 19, 1932 - January 31, 2018

Rod Herrington, 85, of Shubuta, passed away at Wayne General Hospital in Waynesboro on January 31, 2018.

Mr. Herrington was born on March 19, 1932 in Mississippi to Lerner Lee Herrington and Ollie Rhodes Herrington. He worked for Hughes Inc. as a parts manager and was a veteran of the U. S. Air Force. Mr. Herrington was a member of Trinity First Baptist Church in Waynesboro and was a woodworker.
