Sallie White Gough passed away Friday, October 2, 2015.

Born in Arizona on May 16, 1933, Mrs. Gough moved to Dallas, Texas at a young age, graduated from Highland Park High School in Dallas, and attended Mississippi State University where she was a member of the Chi Omega Sorority. She met her husband at Mississippi State and married November 1, 1952, was a secretary for the Land Commissioner in Austin while her husband attended the University of Texas, moved to Dallas in 1959, and to Laurel in 1969 where she was a legal secretary for Robert Sullivan for 18 years.
