



Sara M. Ruffin

February 2, 1920 - November 4, 2014

Sara Foster Maddox Ruffin, 94, devoted wife and mother, was resting in the finished work of Christ and died peacefully on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 in Laurel, Mississippi at Northview Care Center. Born in Memphis, Tennessee on February 2, 1920 to Eva Harwood Maddox and John Edward Maddox, Sr., Sara and her family moved soon after to Starkville, Mississippi where she later met Joseph Ellis (Red) Ruffin of Soso, while he was attending Mississippi State University; they married in 1939. The honeymoon that followed was unusual. Sara's new brother-in-law, Glenn B. Ruffin (age ten) begged to go with them. In her typical spirit of generosity, Sara replied, "Yes, honey, you can go." Not only did Glenn accompany them but so did sister-in-law Vema and husband Carl Ball. Together, they drove to the Gulf Coast for their celebration. To the continuing amusement of her family, the local newspaper's headline had read, "Starkville Girl is Soso Bride." Sara and Red Ruffin had four children, Elizabeth Harwood, Joseph Michael, Russell Ellis, and Sara Lydia. Sara was active in the First Baptist Church of Laurel, as well as numerous civic clubs. Her passions were her family and friends and creating a warm, hospitable home. Preceding her in death were husband J. E. "Red" Ruffin in 1990, daughter Elizabeth in 1947, sister Alliene Everest, and brothers Bill and Jack Maddox. She is survived by her three children and their spouses, seven grandchildren, seven great grandchildren, nieces, nephews, and many friends whom she loved and who loved her. Sara was beautifully cared for during the past two years by our friend, Pat Sloan. The family also wishes to thank her

numerous other caregivers and Deaconess Hospice. Visitation will be at 12:30 PM, followed by the service at 2:00 PM on Friday, November 7, 2014, at Memory Chapel in Laurel.
