



## Sau Lin Chow Li

June 27, 1930 - September 26, 2023

Mrs. Li was born Sau Lin Chow on June 27, 1930 in Hong Kong China to parents, Sui U Chow and Kwan Oi Wan. She emigrated to the United States in August of 1977, and she would plant her roots in Mississippi alongside her eldest son, Tony, who was by her side until her final days. Sau would spend the next 46 years helping to raise her grandchildren between Mississippi, Texas, California and Hong Kong. Aside from her loud voice and boisterous personality, Sau was known for her excellent cooking. Influenced by her father's restaurant, Sau would share these same recipes with her seven children and seventeen grandchildren. She lived a very long and fulfilling life, full of stories, soap opera marathons, and even a national TV show appearance.
