Trevor Christian Aplin passed away on Sunday, July 6, 2025 in Rankin County.

Trevor was born May 2, 2002. He was an active part of Journey Church - belonging to and assisting with the college ministry in recent years.

Trevor had a passion for life and a heart full of hobbies and love. Whether he was bowling, riding motorcycles, playing music, pickleball, or softball, he embraced every moment with energy and joy. He especially cherished watching his sister play volleyball and never passed up a trip to Mexican Kitchen — always sending photos to make the rest of us jealous. In everything he did, Trevor brought joy, energy, and connection. He touched so many lives, and he will be deeply missed.

Trevor was also known for his deep love for Jesus. Anyone who had the chance to see him on the worship team, or simply watch him worship during a service, could see the sincerity of his faith. He had participated in mission trips to the Dominican Republic and Eastern Europe, and was scheduled to intern with Rain Down Ministries in the Dominican Republic during the summer of 2020—plans that were unfortunately halted due to COVID. He had hoped to return on another mission trip in the summer of 2026.

Trevor was actively involved in serving through the college ministry at Journey Church. Before that, he had been dedicated to helping the youth with his friend Joshua at Agape. He was always ready to serve whenever he could, especially when family asked for help.

He was preceded in death by his beloved Papaw, Edward Earl Aplin.

Trevor is survived by his loving parents, Jeff and Kelly Aplin; and his siblings, Bailey Sullivan (along with Samantha and Emma) and Natalie Aplin.

He is also survived by his grandparents, Buddy and Mary Helen Jennings, and Frances Aplin.
