



Troy Lindall Scott

December 17, 1951 - April 8, 2017

Troy Lindall Scott, 65, died peacefully from an extended illness at his residence with his beloved mother and spouse at his side on April 8, 2017.

Mr. Scott was born in Camden, Arkansas on December 17, 1951, and was reared in Chickasaw, Alabama. From an early age he showed outstanding talent as a musician. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree and Masters of Arts degree in Organ Performance from the University of Alabama.

Upon graduation from the University of Alabama, he served as Organist and Director of Music at the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Mobile, Alabama prior to serving two tenures of Organist and Director of Music at St. John's Episcopal Church in Laurel, Mississippi where he was a communicant for over forty years.

Mr. Scott was a founder and co-owner of Pipe Organ Specialties in Laurel and built and repaired pipe organs throughout the US and South Korea.

He was an instrument rated pilot and built an airplane. As an avid yachtsman he owned and captained sailboats resulting in his affiliation as past Captain of the Central Gulf Fleet of the Cape Dory Sailboat Association.

Survivors of Mr. Scott include his spouse, Henry Madison Lindsey, III, Laurel,

Miss; his mother, LaVerne Garner Scott, Chickasaw, Ala.; brother, Dwayne Scott (Diane), Theodore, Ala.; sisters, Lynette Steen (David), Saraland, Ala.; and Janine Beasley, Laurel, Miss; and Antonio Moreno, special friend, Laurel, Miss.

His father, Doyal Edman Scott of Chickasaw, Ala, preceded Mr. Scott in death.

Visitation will be held in the chapel of St. Johns Episcopal Church at 11:30, Saturday, April 29, 2017 with the funeral service following the visitation at 1:00 at the church. The ashes will be interred into the Columbarium in St. Johns courtyard following the funeral service. The Very Reverend Thomas P. Rosa and The Reverend Jeffrey W. Reich will officiate the liturgy.
