Voncile Drennan Corum died at her home Monday, October 21, 2013.

She was born August 19, 1929. She graduated from Soso High School and attended JCJC and Southern Miss where she was in the first pledge class of Kappa Delta Sorority on campus.

She was married to David Corum, Jr. on May 19, 1951 at First Baptist Church of Laurel.

As co-owner of Corum's Florist, Antique & Gifts, she ran her antique shop over 50 years in Corum's and for 35 years was an agent of Judy C. Martin China, Silver, and Crystal Shop.

She was a member of First Baptist Church, Society of American Florists, Laurel Junior Auxiliary, Daughters of the American Revolution, Northwood Garden Club, Kappa Delta Alumni Association, she was one of the very first docents at the Lauren Rogers Museum of Art, and she served on the committee to certify Gibbons Georgian Silver Collection for the Lauren Rogers Museum.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Luther Drennan and her son, David Corum, III.
