Wilmer Jeremiah (W. Jay) Mason age 81 of Ellisville, Mississippi went home to be with the Lord on November 21, 2014. Services will be held at Memory Chapel in Laurel on Monday, November 24th at 10:00 am with burial to follow at Serenity Gardens in Waynesboro Mississippi. Visitation will be on Sunday evening November 23rd from 5 to 8pm at Memory Chapel.
