William Sam Chancellor, Sr., 86, of Laurel, died Thursday, June 2, 2011 at South Central Regional Medical Center in Laurel. Funeral services will be held at 10 am Saturday, June 4, 2011 at Memory Chapel of Laurel with burial in Sharon Cemetery in Jones County. Dr. Ken Regan will officiate. Mr. Chancellor served as a corporal in the U. S. Army during World War II. He served tours of duty in Italy and Germany. While in Germany, he was a part of the occupational army for one year.
