He also attended William Carey University in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, where he received his Masters of Education. He was a retired junior and high school educator/administrator, athletic coach, and central office administrator for the West Point, Jones County, and Laurel City School Districts. He also was also an active championship- level member of the Mississippi Track Club and competed professionally in races across the southeast for over 30 years.

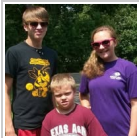
