William Lavelle Herrington, 77, of Laurel died Sunday, August 14, 2011 at the Veterans Home in Collins. Funeral services will be held at 11:30 am Wednesday, August 17, 2011 at Trinity Baptist Church, with burial to follow at Pleasant Ridge Cemetery. Rev. Keith Yelverton and Rev.
